#### **RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. Owners of all Pure-bred Irish Draught horses in affiliated In-hand & Ridden classes must be FULL members of the IDHS(GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport horses.
- Classes 1 11 & 17 20 are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses
  registered with or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for
  entry.
- 3. All Pure-Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register. All yearling, two- and three-year-old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three-year-old colts must be un-inspected Stallions (In hand or ridden) must also be inspected and over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) All RIDDEN Pure bred Irish Draughts must be registered with or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership.
- 4. All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and must display a red, white, and blue ribbon in their tails.
- 5. All **RIDDEN** Irish Draught Sport Horses must be in the correct ownership, have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse. All ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over and must display a red, white, and blue ribbon in their tails.
- 6. **All Irish Draught Sport Horse Breeding and Youngstock in Hand** exhibits must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. All yearling, two- and three-year-old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three-year-old colts must be un-inspected.
- 7. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility.
- 8. Competitors may enter more than one class, but the Show Team will not be responsible if clashes occur.
- 9. \*\*On The Day entries for affiliated IDHS (GB) classes can only be accepted as additional entries for animals already entered in another affiliated class.
- 10. All entry forms <u>must</u> be <u>fully</u> completed, and the <u>correct fees</u> paid to be eligible for entry to the appropriate classes.
- 11. No entries without appropriate First Aid fee for each rider /handler.



- 12. No entry fee refunds except for cancellation of the Show or a Class by the Show Team prior to the event.
- 13. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors have public liability insurance, confirmation to be given on the entry form.
- 14. Spot checks will be made of proof of public liability insurance, please bring documents, or a clear photograph.
- 15. All competitor numbers to be collected on the day. In line with DEFRA regulations, random passports checks will be done when you collect your back number.
- 16. By entering this show you give your consent to personal data being held and processed by IDHS(GB) in accordance with the Society's Privacy Policy (available on the website at https://idhsgb.org.uk/legal/privacy-policy/ and UK General Data Protection Regulation.
- 17. **Health and Safety:** The Show Committee accept no responsibility for accidents to spectators, competitors, animals, or their property, in connection with or arising from the Show. Admission is granted and entries accepted only on recognition of this condition. The Yorkshire Irish Draught & Hunter Show accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from any failure to comply with the Show Rules. No rider/handler under sixteen years of age on the day of the show is eligible to compete in any classes. \*Riders & handlers of colts and stallions MUST be at least 18years old. Proof of age may be required.
- 18. **The Judge's decision is final**. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a £50 cash deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
- 19. The Show Committee reserves the right to rearrange times, amalgamate or cancel classes, and adjust prize money accordingly. They also reserve the sole right to interpret rules and conditions and to finally settle and determine all or any matter, question, or difference arising from Show policy.
- 20. Bitless bridles, running gags, Market Harborough's, side, draw, or running reins are not allowed in any class. The use of Swales, Sam Marsh bits, and gags with double bridles are actively discouraged.
- 21. Boots and martingales are not permitted in any flat-ridden class.
- 22. No tack which conceals an animal's conformation or identifies an animal, its owner, or sponsor is allowed in any ring.
- 23. It is the sole responsibility of all riders to ensure that whilst mounted, they wear appropriate clothing and footwear and a correctly fitting riding hat/skull cap with an integral adjustable harness complying with the minimum current European standards. These hats are compulsory for competitors aged 18 years and under. This also applies to handlers and grooms.



- 24. If in the judges/steward's opinion any horse is regarded to compromise the safety of other competitors or spectators, they will be asked to leave the ring.
- 25. A fall of horse or rider in any ridden class will lead to elimination from the class.
- 26. Parents/carers of children and young people under the age of 16 years are responsible for their supervision at all times whilst at the Show.
- 27. Dogs are allowed but MUST be on a short lead at all times. (No flexi or extending leads in the vicinity of any horse, ring, box, car park or stable areas). Owners must clean up all mess after their pets.
- 28. No Smoking in the stable or any indoor area.
- 29. Equine Flu Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccination booster (an initial primary course of 3 injections is required for horses more than 5 months old. The second is given between 21 and 92 days after the first and the third is given between 150 and 215 days after the second, and then booster vaccinations given annually thereafter). Must have had their second vaccination at least **7 days** prior to the show.
- 30. No ridden horses permitted into the collecting ring until the final In Hand Class / championship has entered the ring.

#### The Moorbennhall Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge:

This show is a Qualifier for The Moorbennhall Irish Draught Youngstock Challenge. The two highest placed pure-breds from each age group that have not already qualified in Classes 1, 2, and 3 - yearlings, two year olds and three year olds - eligible for Class 1 in the Irish Draught Breed Register by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) sire, out of a Graded Mare, or if one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify to go forward to their respective final, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th September 2024 at Willoughby Park Equestrian Centre, Rugby CV23 8AJ. In the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship where the Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.

CLASS 1	Irish Draught Yearling - filly, colt, or gelding, by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) sire out of a Graded dam.
CLASS 2	Irish Draught Two-Year-Old - filly, colt or gelding, by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) sire out of a Graded dam.
CLASS 3	Irish Draught Three-Year-Old - filly, un-inspected colt, or gelding, by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) sire out of a Graded dam.
CLASS 4	Irish Draught Mare/Brood Mare - Graded Class 1 or Class 2 mare, three years old and over, with own foal at foot, or Graded Class 1 or Class 2 mare four years old and over, barren or in foal. <b>Rosette</b> to highest placed brood mare with foal at foot.
CLASS 5	Irish Draught Filly or Colt Foal - Produce of a Graded mare entered or eligible for entry in the above class, and eligible for Class 1 on the Irish Draught Breed Register.

#### The IDHS (GB) Sport Horse Youngstock Challenge:

This show is a Qualifier for The IDHS (GB) Sport Horse Youngstock Challenge. The two highest placed Sport Horses from each age group that have not already qualified in Classes 6 & 7 - yearlings, two year olds and three year olds (must have a minimum of 25% proven ID breeding) - or if one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify to go forward to the final, which will be held at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th September 2024 at Willoughby Park, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ. In the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship where the Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150.

CLASS 6	Irish Draught Sport Horse Yearling - filly, colt, or gelding, registered on the ID Spor Horse Register.
CLASS 7	Irish Draught Sport Horse Two- and Three-Year-Old - filly, colt, or gelding, registered on the ID Sport Horse Register.  This class will be split if there are sufficient entries in each age group.
CLASS 8	Irish Draught Sport Horse Mare/Brood Mare - Mare, four years old and over, barren, in foal or with own foal at foot, registered on the ID Sport Horse Register.
CLASS 9	Irish Draught Sport Horse Filly or Colt Foal - eligible for the ID Sport Horse Register.  From mare in either Class 5 or Class 8 offspring to have a min 25% proven ID breeding. (An ID Sport Horse foal at foot from a brood mare that is not a registered ID Sport Horse is eligible for Class 9. The Mare is not eligible for Class

any breed to exceed 15hh at maturity.

CLASS 13 IN HAND HUNTER Open to mare or gelding 4 years old and over.

## SUPREME IN HAND SEMI FINAL SUPREME IN-HAND HORSE OR PONY OF THE YEAR SEMI FINAL

JUDGE: Championship 3 – Guest Judge to be announced before the championship

The following class is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final at the National Pony Society Great British In-Hand Show, 7th September 2024. Which is a qualifier for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 9th -13th October 2024. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses). The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2024. The champions from Championship 1 (from classes 1-5), and Championship 2 (from classes 6-9). If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2024 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to The NPS Great British In-Hand Show, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2024 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at the NPS Great British In-Hand Show. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show. In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi-Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections. All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter



with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year. There will be no direct entry into the Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable). Judges need not be registered on any society Judge's panel but must possess sufficient experience to judge. CLASS 16	RIDDEN HUNTER (Including SMALL HUNTERS) & SPORTS HORSES Over 148cm, mare or gelding 4yrs and over.

### **IDHS (GB) AFFILIATED IRISH DRAUGHT RIDDEN CLASSES**

IDHS (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge.

This show is a qualifier for the IDHS(GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge.

The highest placed horses (not already qualified) from each of the following Classes 17 & 18 will qualify for the final of the IDHS (GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge which will be held at the at the IDHS (GB) National Championship Show on 7<sup>th</sup> and 8th September 2024 at Willoughby Park, Willoughby, Rugby, Warwickshire CV23 8AJ. A horse may only qualify for the final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, and a trophy the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Purebred Irish Draught will receive a trophy and £100, and the highest placed Sport Horse will receive a trophy and £50.



CLASS 17 Ridden Irish Draught - 4 years old and over, stallion (see Eligibility Criteria), mare or gelding registered on the Irish Draught Breed Register.

CLASS 18 Ridden Irish Draught Sport Horse – 4 years old and over, stallion (see Eligibility Criteria), mare or gelding on the ID Sport Horse Register.

## Agria Royal International Horse Show British Horse Feeds and Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) Ridden Championship Series.

JUDGE: Ride - Ms. Michelle Underwood Conformation – Mr. Andrew Gardiner

This show is a qualifier for the British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series The 3 highest placed horses (not already qualified) from Classes 19 and 20 will qualify for the final to be held at the Royal International Horse Show Hickstead, on July 27th 2024. Qualification can be passed to 4th place if the highest placed horses have already qualified and if in the opinion of the judges, the exhibit is of sufficient quality. Pure bred Irish Draught horses must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB). Pure bred stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID, or Supplementary Grade Up) by an ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class 1 Class 2, or RID(GB). Owners of Pure Bred Irish Draught horses must be FULL members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB). Irish Draught Sport Horses (including stallions) must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. Owners do not have to be members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) All horses must be in the correct ownership and must be 4years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over. N.B. Stallions MUST be ridden and handled by an experienced person over the age of 18 and identified by a white and red tail ribbon (there are many grey ID and IDSH)

CLASS 19 Ridden Pure bred Irish Draught – first 3 to qualify. Open to mares, stallions and geldings 4 years and over, registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB).

CLASS 20 Ridden Irish Draught Sport Horse – first 3 to qualify. Open to mares, stallions and geldings 4 years and over, registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

CHAMPIONSHIP 4 RIDDEN SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP
