IN HAND PURE BRED IRISH DRAUGHT CLASSES

* A Graded mare or filly is one which has been inspected by the IDHS (GB) and passed into one of the following categories:
ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID or the Supplementary Grade Up Register

- CLASS 1 # YEARLING COLT, FILLY OR GELDING by an RID (GB), ID Class 1 or Class 2 sire, out of a *graded mare
- CLASS 2 # 2 YEAR OLD FILLY, GELDING OR COLT. by an RID (GB), ID Class 1 or Class 2 sire, out of a *graded mare
- CLASS 3 # 3 YEAR OLD FILLY OR GELDING & UNINSPECTED COLTS. by an RID (GB), ID Class 1 or Class 2 sire, out of a *graded mare
- CLASS 4 # *GRADED MARE (in foal or barren) 4 years and over.
- CLASS 5 # * BROOD MARE (with own foal at foot) 3 years and over.
- CLASS 6 # FILLY or COLT FOAL From *graded mare entered or eligible for entry in Class 5 and eligible for Class 1 on the ID Breed Register

IN HAND IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSES CLASSES

- CLASS 7 # ID SPORT HORSE YEARLING COLT, FILLY OR GELDING Registered on the ID Sport Horse Register
- CLASS 8 # ID SPORT HORSE 2 YEAR OLD FILLY, GELDING OR COLT Registered on the ID Sport Horse Register
- CLASS 9 # ID SPORT HORSE 3 YEAR OLD FILLY OR GELDING & UNINSPECTED COLTS Registered on the ID Sport Horse Register
- CLASS 10 # ID SPORT HORSE BROOD MARE. (in foal or with own foal at foot) 4 yrs & over registered on the ID Sport Horse Register
- CLASS 11 # FOAL - COLT OR FILLY From mare in either **Class 5** or **Class 10** eligible for the ID Sport Horse Register ie min 25% proven ID breeding. (An ID Sport Horse foal at foot from a brood mare that is not a registered ID Sport Horse is eligible for Class 11. The Mare is not eligible for Class 10)

IN HAND IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd from Classes 7 - 11 to compete

Main Arena: to follow previous Championships

A Special rosette will be awarded to the Highest Placed Veteran (over 15 yrs) in Classes 12 & 13

CLASS 12 IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE MATURITY 4 years and over stallion, mare or gelding registered on the ID Sport Horse Register

CLASS 13 IRISH DRAUGHT MATURITY 4 years and over stallion, mare or gelding registered on the IDHS (GB) Breed Register

ID & IDSH MATURITY IN HAND ID CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd from Classes 12 & 13 to compete

OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES *These classes are open to any breed of horse including Irish Draughts*

CLASS 14 # OPEN RIDDEN NOVICE Over 15hh, any breed. Stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs and over. **Not to have been placed 1st in any ridden class before 1st January 2021**

CLASS 15 OPEN RIDDEN SMALL HUNTER / COB / MAXI COB any breed stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs and over. Small Hunter (148cm / 14.2hh but not exceeding 15.2 hh (158cm). Cobs / Maxi Cobs exceeding 14.2 hh (148cm)

CLASS 16 # OPEN RIDDEN HUNTER Over 15hh, any breed.

OPEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd from Classes 14 – 16 to compete

Champion to receive £30 and Reserve to receive £15

AFFILIATED RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT CLASSES

CLASS 17 # RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT – PURE BRED Stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs & over registered on the Irish Draught Breed Register (Main Studbook)

CLASS 18 # RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT - SPORT HORSE Stallion, mare or gelding 4yrs & over registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register

RIDDEN IRISH DRAUGHT CHAMPIONSHIP 1st & 2nd from Classes 17 & 18 to compete

IMPORTANT ENTRY INFORMATION

Owners of all Pure-bred Irish Draught horses in affiliated In-hand & Ridden classes must be **FULL** members of the IDHS(GB). This rule does not apply to owners of Irish Draught Sport horses.

Classes 1 – 13 & 17 - 18 are affiliated to the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) and only horses registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership are eligible for entry.

- All Pure Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (ID Class1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.
- All Sport Horses must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.
- All competing STALLIONS must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (ID Class1, Class2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) by a Class 1 Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as RID (GB), ID Class 1 or ID Class 2 OR be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse Stallion, and they must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails.
- All riders of STALLIONS must be 18 years of age or over.
- All in-hand stallions and 1, 2 and 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years or over.
- All ridden horses must be 4 years and over and meet the class criteria for entry.
- Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility.

Competitors may enter more than one class but the Show Team will not be responsible if clashes occur

- Entry forms must be fully completed and the correct entry fees (including First Aid Fee) enclosed to be eligible for entry to the appropriate classes.
No entries accepted without the appropriate First Aid fee
- No entry fee refunds except for cancellation of the Show or a Class by the Show Team
- All competitor numbers to be collected on the day. (* See note below)

EQUINE FLU: Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccination booster **OR**
Must have had their second vaccination **7 days** prior to the show.
*Remember in line with DEFRA regulations, passports should always be carried and available to be checked.
Passports may be checked at the show when you collect your back number.

Veterans: A Special Rosette will be awarded to the Highest Placed Veteran (Over 15 years) in each of the Maturity classes (Classes 12 & 13)

Sport Horse Breeding In the North West: Points Scheme

This scheme will be in operation for both In-hand and Ridden classes marked with an #.

To qualify for points, horses must be registered with or overstamped by SHB (GB) to qualify.

In-hand Classes: Points will be awarded to the horses placed 1st to 4th and in the event of a tie; any championships will be taken into consideration. The following classes will be taken into consideration for points:

In-hand Irish Draughts

In-hand Irish Draught Sport Horses

The Gilbertson Trophy will be awarded to the horse attaining the highest number of overall points at the end of the season

Ridden Classes: Points will be awarded to the horses placed 1st to 4th and, in the event of a tie; any championships will be taken into consideration. The following classes will be taken into consideration for points:

Open Ridden Small; Open Ridden Hunter; Ridden Irish Draught & Irish Draught Sport Horse.

Sport Horse Breeding In the North West will make an award to the horse attaining the highest number of overall points at the end of the season.

GENERAL RULES

1. AGE OF RIDER/HANDLER. No rider/handler under sixteen years of age on the day of the show is eligible to compete in any classes. (Riders & handlers of colts and stallions MUST be 18) Proof of age may be required.
2. The Judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a £50 cash deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
3. The Show Team reserves the right to rearrange times, amalgamate or cancel classes and adjust prizes money accordingly. They also reserve the sole right to interpret rules and conditions and to finally settle and determine all or any matter, question or difference arising from Show policy.
4. The Show Team accepts no responsibility for accidents to spectators, competitors, animals or their property in connection with or arising from the show. Admission is granted and entries accepted only on recognition of this condition. The IDHS (GB) accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from failure to comply with these show rules.
5. Bitless bridles, running gags, market harboroughs, side, draw or running reins are not allowed in any class. The use of Swales, Sam Marsh bits and gags with double bridles are actively discouraged. Boots and martingales are not permitted in any flat ridden class.
6. No tack which conceals an animal's conformation or identifies an animal, its owner or sponsor is allowed in any ring.
7. It is the sole responsibility of all riders to ensure that whilst mounted, they wear appropriate clothing and footwear and a correctly fitted riding hat which complies with the minimum current European standards.
8. All handlers and Grooms are also advised to wear a properly fitted hard hat or skull cap to current European standards whilst leading or working any horse inside or outside the ring.
9. If in the judges/stewards opinion any horse is regarded to compromise the safety of other competitors or spectators, they will be asked to leave the ring.
10. A fall of horse or rider in any ridden class will lead to elimination from the class.
11. Parents/carers of children and young people under the age of 16 years are responsible for their supervision at all times whilst at the Show. No prams or pushchairs are allowed in the arenas.
12. Dogs are allowed in the outdoor areas of the Show but MUST be on a short lead at all times. (No flexi or extending leads in the vicinity of any horse, ring, box, car park or stable areas) Owners must clean up all mess after their pets.
13. No Smoking in the International Arena or near stables
