



Stallion & Spring Mare Inspections at Onley Grounds – Wednesday 5 April 2023

Following an outbreak of EHV 1 at our previous venue, Onley Grounds Equestrian Centre very kindly came up trumps and accommodated us at short notice, for a very reasonable cost. Our veterinary advisor, Liam Kearns MRCVS, kindly offered to come to Onley to vet the horses on the day.

Four stallions and five mares came forward. It was good to see so many mares prepared to undertake the jumping lane, which is voluntary for mares, with two mares achieving the necessary score for athleticism to achieve a Bronze Merit Award. A third mare achieved a Bronze Merit Award for conformation and movement.

All the British-bred stallions received a BLS Award, comprising a rosette and sash. These awards are kindly donated by the late Mr Bernard Symonds and our Life Patron, Mrs Pam Symonds. The Irish-bred Class 1 stallions received a rosette and sash kindly donated by Horse Sport Ireland.

The stallion inspectors were Gillian Devenney from Ireland, Mark Fitton and John Newborough from Great Britain. Andrew Gardiner came over from Ireland to support and lead our excellent arena team. Andrew also kindly stepped in join the mare inspections when we were delayed over lunch and ran into flight time issues.

The Society is extremely grateful to all who brought horses forward and the very large number of loyal volunteers who, at their own expense, come every year to help on the day. We greatly appreciate everyone's contribution.
