Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) mare inspection report and results 2022

This year saw another very positive year for our mare inspections, with 75 mares forward out of around 100 expressions of interest. The very hot weather this summer took its toll and we lost a significant number of mares from the programme because they became footsore on the hard ground. Of the 75 mares that were inspected for grading at 15 different venues covering Scotland, England and Wales, 49 (65.3%) achieved Class 1, with two mares achieving a Bronze Merit in conformation and movement.

25 mares passed the vet but did not meet all of the inspection standards for Class 1, so they are classified as Class 2. There were no applications for assessment for a Bronze Merit in show jumping this year. We are offering this facility for mares during the 2023 stallion inspections on 5 April and in October.

Nine mares were awarded a Hornby Premium. Two mares this year have achieved their third Hornby Premium and have attained 'Select' status. This is equivalent to a Bronze Merit in Conformation and Movement. Select mares can have their Irish Draught foals registered free of charge. Sadly, one of the new Select mares, 13-year-old Ballynamona Lady owned by Kelly Gatland and on loan to Tony Phillips and Sarah Bright-Phillips, died a few weeks after achieving her third Hornby Premium. She had also, in a previous year, achieved a Bronze Merit Award in Show Jumping. Her demise is a great loss to the breed and our condolences go to all of those who owned, produced or cared for this lovely mare over the years.

There is understandable confusion about the criteria we use to determine whether a horse is Class 1 or Class 2. Show ring success is often a factor in this confusion, but inspection is not the same as judging. An animal's show record reflects what else was in the ring on the day. Conversely, an animal which has not appealed to a judge in the show ring may well meet all the standards required for Class 1 on inspection. Judging is a subjective process, but the inspection is much less so, because horses are assessed against the Breed Standard and not against each other. Inspectors' personal preferences must never come into the decision-making.

We are of course biased, but we as the Inspection Management Team believe firmly that it is worth having Irish Draught mares and stallions inspected, not least because the breeder knows that as a minimum, they are breeding from stock which has passed the vet. Foals by and out of inspected parents can go on to be inspected in their own right. Class 2 mares and their progeny can also be shown in hand.

The better quality Class 2 mares which meet some of the required minimum marks for conformation, type and movement can still be useful members of the breeding herd. Bred to stallions which have complementary strengths, they can potentially produce foals which can help to improve the breed. In my personal opinion, if a mare or a stallion (whether Class 1 or Class 2) with one or more significant faults tends to throw this trait with different partners, then owners should consider the wisdom of continuing to breed from them.

All owners receive a typed report on their horse, including the linear profile, vet report and comments made by the inspection panel. There is no such thing as a perfect horse. For this reason, it is important to study your horse's linear profile, and if there is something you don't understand, please do ask. If you buy a horse that was inspected in Great Britain, you can request its inspection report from the Inspection Management Team at inspections@idhsgb.org.uk.

Looking forward to 2023, we have plans for stallion inspections in the spring and autumn, and mare inspections at both of those venues, plus other venues around the country.

The serious economic situation facing many countries in the world at the moment has had an impact on the cost of living, and particularly on the cost of fossil fuels. During the course of 2022, our veterinary costs escalated. Some vets managed to provide a service for a similar cost to 2021, especially at the early venues in June and July, but the mare inspections held later in the year turned out to be very expensive for us. The average vet's fee per mare in 2022 was £115, with a range from £86 to £155, compared with £90 in previous years. We had to honour our commitment to charge only £90 to the owners, because our fees are always set at the end of the previous year. At that point, we had no way to predict that there was going to be a war in Eastern Europe and an international economic challenge.

After holding inspection costs stable for some years, we had no choice but to increase both mare and stallion inspection fees for 2023. This increase would have been greater still were it not for the kindness and generosity of all those volunteers, both on and outside the Council, who help year after year, often at considerable financial cost to themselves. We are very mindful that the increases are difficult for everybody, but the Council will keep the situation under review and will not charge more than we need to in order to cover our costs for inspections.

The kind generosity of local Irish Draught enthusiasts and others who allowed us to use their premises free of charge this year, notably Bowland Stud in Lancashire, Brook Farm Equestrian Centre in Lincolnshire, Cheston Farm Equestrian Centre in Devon, Classic Top Stud in Kent, Shona Moss and Ashley Davies in South West Wales, helped us to keep our costs down. Some also provided very welcome refreshments for us, and this is much appreciated. We would also like to thank the numerous enthusiastic members, some of whom are relatively new to the breed, who came to help at different venues around the country. We literally could not run these events without all of you.
