GENERAL RULES:

Important: It is a condition of entry that all owners/exhibitors must have 3rd party public liability insurance for their horses to compete

- 1) **The Show Team** reserves the right to rearrange times, amalgamate or cancel classes and adjust prize money accordingly. They also reserve the sole right to interpret rules and conditions and to finally settle and determine all or any matter, question or difference arising from Show policy.
- 2) **Health and Safety:** The Show Team accept no responsibility for accidents to spectators, competitors, animals or their property, in connection with or arising from the Show. Admission is granted and entries accepted only on recognition of this condition. The IDHS(GB) accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from any failure to comply with the Show Rules.
Horses: must move around the Showground using the horse walks at a walking pace. There should be no pedestrians in the horse walks – Please refer to SITE PLAN that is included with this schedule
Children: Parents/Carers of children and young people under the age of 16 years are responsible for their supervision at all times while attending the Show. No prams or pushchairs are allowed in the arenas
Dogs: are welcome to attend the outdoor areas of the Show but **MUST** be kept on a short lead at all times (NO FLEXI OR EXTENDING LEADS IN THE VICINITY OF ANY HORSE, RING, BOX/CAR PARKS OR STABLE AREA. Owners must pick up and safely dispose of any dog excrement.
No smoking in the stable blocks or any of the arenas.
- 3) **Riders and handlers:** It is the sole responsibility of all to ensure that whilst mounted, they wear appropriate clothing and footwear and a correctly fitting, secured riding hat/skull cap with an integral adjustable harness complying with the minimum current European standards.
These hats are compulsory for competitors aged 18 years and under and for all competitors in jumping classes.
This also applies to handlers and grooms
No rider/handler under sixteen years of age on the day of the show is eligible to compete in any classes. Riders & handlers of colts and stallions **MUST** be 18 years or over. Proof of age may be required.
- 4) **Judging: It is the responsibility of the owner and/or exhibitor to ensure they do not enter a horse in a class under a Judge** who may have bred, owned, sold or had any financial interest in at any time. The practice of a Judge advising on the purchase of, exhibiting, schooling or having at livery any horse(s) for someone or their immediate family and then judging any horses for the same owner during the current or previous year is prohibited by the Society. [Service fees for stallions and keep for mares whilst at stud are excluded]. Judges must not knowingly judge a horse produced by a producer, owner or their immediate families for whom they have shown any horse or has shown any horse for them during the current or previous year. If there is an unforeseen change of Judge then the owner or exhibitor must stand down from the class

The Judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a £50 cash deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
If in the opinion of the judges/stewards any horse is regarded to compromise the safety of other competitors, horses or spectators, they will be asked to leave the ring.
A fall of horse or rider in any ridden class will lead to elimination from the class.
- 5) **Tack:** Bitless bridles, running gags, Market Harboroughs, side, draw or running reins are NOT allowed in any class. The use of Swales, Sam Marsh bits and gags with double bridles are actively discouraged. Chifney bits are not permitted to be used in any classes.
Boots and martingales are not permitted in any flat ridden class. Martingales are allowed in jumping classes and front boots only are permitted for the jumping phase
No tack which conceals an animal's conformation or identifies an animal, its owner or sponsor is allowed in any ring.

ENTRY INFORMATION

Owners of all Pure-bred Irish Draught horses in affiliated In-hand & Ridden classes must be FULL members of the IDHS(GB). This rule does not apply to owners of ID Sport Horses.

- All horses must be in the correct ownership
- Pure Bred Irish Draughts** entered in Breeding and Youngstock In-hand exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded / Inspected Mare (ID Class 1, 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up) and be by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register.
- ID Sport Horses** must have a minimum of 25% proven breeding and be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.
- Ridden horses** must be 4 years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over and registered in the IDHS(GB) main studbook or on the IDSH register.
- Maturity In Hand** exhibits must be registered in the IDHS(GB) main studbook or on the IDSH register.
- All competing stallions** must be the progeny of a Graded / Inspected Mare (ID Class 1, 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up) by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) stallion and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) **OR** be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse Stallion.
In-hand stallions and 1, 2 and 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years or over. All riders of stallions must be 18 years of age or over.
Stallions must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails and a white disc on their bridle.
- Height Certificates:** For horses entered in a height regulated class or competing for a special award a current, valid height certificate must be provided. Any horse without a valid height certificate will not be allowed to compete.
- Horses, where appropriate, may enter more than one class but the Show Team will not be responsible if clashes occur.

STYLE JUMPING CLASS

Walled Arena not before 15:30

Class 19 – Style Jumping class – Fences height between 80 & 90cm

Judge: Mark Mortimer

The horse enters the arena , the rider halts and salutes the judge , then proceeds in canter whilst their position and balance is assessed before jumping. They are expected to work mainly in canter showing changes of paces and transitions on straight lines and small circles. Up to 10 marks is awarded at this stage . The signal to start is given and the course jumped ,the rider is judged on how they ride the whole course , particular attention being given to how they ride the turns and present the horse to the fence . The judge will award marks for the round:

1. Equestrian feel and skill , ability to present the horse correctly at the fence and ride accurate lines .The ability to maintain a clear rhythm and correct pace . Confidence. Ability to influence the horse correctly.

2. Riders leg position, balance and ability to follow the horse's movement over the fence .Security of lower leg . Independence of the rein

3. Horse's balance and rhythm. Desire to move forward , attention and confidence, harmony, lightness and ease of movement, acceptance of the bridle , calmness of the jump .

Penalties will be awarded as follows:

- Knocking down any part of an obstacle including the wing 2 penalties
- First refusal on the whole course. 3 penalties
- Second refusal on whole course. 6 penalties
- Third refusal on the whole course. Elimination
- Fall of horse and / or rider. Elimination
- Taking the wrong course. Elimination
- Failing to salute the judge Elimination
- Commencing the course before the signal to start Elimination

This show is a qualifier for the **2025** IDHS(GB) £2,000 Ridden Challenge.
