HORNBY LONSDALE TRUST - PREMIUM APPLICATION FORM 2025

CLOSING DATE: 15 July 2025

In order to qualify for a Hornby Premium inspection, mares:

- Must be either RID, Class 1, Supplementary Grade Up or AID, or a traditionally-bred half-bred Irish Draught Sport Horse mare with fully documented 50% Irish Draught pedigree, the other half to be Class 1 Connemara, General Studbook-registered Thoroughbred or traditionally-bred Irish Draught Sport Horse ONLY).
- Must have their own foal at foot by a Class 1 or RID stallion.

Mares forward for grading may go on to be inspected for a possible Hornby Premium provided that they achieve Class 1. They should meet FEI vaccination requirements, as for grading.

Owners (or borrowers, if the mare is on loan) must be full members of the Society. Mares must be in the correct ownership and registered with or overstamped by the Society.

Young members and handlers under 18 years are very welcome to apply.

Foals should not be expected to travel to a venue unless they are mature enough to do so safely. Mares will not be inspected at home, unless they are very close to the route of an inspection tour for grading.

There is no fee for a Hornby Premium inspection. You can apply before the foal is born.

Venues and dates for the 2025 Hornby Premium Mare Inspections are as follows. Firm dates in bold. More dates will be added, but we will not know the final venue list until the after the closing date (15 July).

To obtain a premium, mares must score 125 marks out of a possible 145 marks on a numerical score sheet, based on conformation, type and movement in hand. They are not turned loose unless they are also being inspected for grading, where this is a requirement.

Successful mares receive a beautiful Hornby Premium rosette and, if funds are available, a grant, which is payable at the end of the year.

Mares which have been awarded three Hornby Premiums are termed **Select mares** and receive a Select rosette. They can then have their foals by Class 1 stallions registered free of charge.
