Mares aged **3 years or older** will be given the opportunity to have their athleticism assessed by means of a loose jumping demonstration. Mares which achieve **Class 1** or **Grade Up** on inspection and which **achieve a score of 70 or higher in athleticism will be awarded a Bronze Merit in Showjumping.**

Mares aged four years old and over may ask to be assessed under saddle (own rider) if the owner wishes. Whether this is possible in any given year will depend on how many applicants wish to do this, due to the cost of hiring show jumps for this purpose.

Uninspected Irish Draught fillies and mares, plus re-inspection of Class 2 fillies and mares.	£240	The basic fee includes inspection, optional athleticism assessment (held at the two venues which cater for stallions only, where we have jumping facilities) and vetting on the day.
Athleticism assessment of Irish Draught Purebred Mares previously classified as RID, Class 1 or Supp. Grade-Up.	£170	The fee includes initial linear profiling (if the mare is RID and has not been profiled), a brief trot-up veterinary assessment and jumping lane assessment.
Non-returnable administration charge for mares.	£120	Because we make financial commitments when booking venues, the Society has the right to retain this portion of the fee if a mare is withdrawn <b>within six weeks of the inspection date</b> .  A veterinary certificate will be required if withdrawn on veterinary grounds.
