## RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Classes 14 – 17, 22 – 26, 34 & 35** All horses must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership. **Owners** of Pure bred Irish Draughts **and** Irish Draught Sport Horses/Part bred) **must** now be **full members** of the IDHS (GB) to compete
2. **Irish Draught Sport Horses/Part bred** are horses that have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding
3. **In hand breeding classes** MARES with foals at foot, 3 years and over must be inspected and classified as Class 1 (or RID), Class 2 or Supplementary Grade Up (or AID)
4. Pure bred ID and ID Sport Horse / Part bred, 3 year old colts must be un-inspected
5. All 1, 2 & 3 year old colts must be bitted and shown by experienced handlers over 18 years of age
  
6. **All pure-bred Irish Draught Stallions** must be inspected and overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB).
7. Stallions must display a red, white and blue ribbon in their tails and be shown by experienced rider/handlers over 18 years of age
  
8. Ridden horses must be 153cm (15hh) or over.
  
1. **All Pure-Bred Breeding and Youngstock In-hand** exhibits must be the progeny of a Graded Mare (Class 1, Class 2, RID (GB), AID or Supplementary Grade Up Register) and be by a Class 1, Class 2 or RID (GB) stallion on the Irish Draught Breed Register. All yearling, two- and three-year-old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three-year-old colts must be un-inspected Stallions (In hand or ridden) must also be inspected and over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and be Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) All RIDDEN Pure bred Irish Draughts must be registered with or over stamped by the IDHS (GB) and in the correct ownership.
2. All **RIDDEN** Irish Draught Sport Horses must be in the correct ownership, have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be a Registered Irish Draught Sport Horse.
3. **All Irish Draught Sport Horse Breeding and Youngstock in Hand** exhibits must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register. All yearling, two- and three-year-old COLTS must be bitted and shown by an experienced handler of 18 years of age or over. All three-year-old colts must be un-inspected.
4. Registration numbers to be stated on the entry form and entries will be sent to the IDHS (GB) prior to the Show to confirm eligibility.
5. Competitors may enter more than one class, but the Show Team will not be responsible if clashes occur.



6. All entry forms must be fully completed, and the correct fees paid to be eligible for entry to the appropriate classes. Note entries on the day are CASH ONLY.
7. No entries without appropriate First Aid fee for each rider /handler.
8. No entry fee refunds except for cancellation of the Show or a Class by the Show Team prior to the event, a reasonable administration fee will be deducted.
9. It is a condition of entry that all exhibitors have public liability insurance, confirmation to be given on the entry form.
10. Spot checks will be made of proof of public liability insurance, please bring documents, or a clear photograph.
11. All competitor numbers to be collected on the day. In line with DEFRA regulations, random passports checks will be done when you collect your back number.
12. By entering this show you give your consent to personal data being held and processed by IDHS(GB) in accordance with the Society's Privacy Policy (available on the website at <https://idhsgb.org.uk/legal/privacy-policy/> and UK General Data Protection Regulation.
13. **Health and Safety:** The Show Committee accept no responsibility for accidents to spectators, competitors, animals, or their property, in connection with or arising from the Show. Admission is granted and entries accepted only on recognition of this condition. The Yorkshire Irish Draught & Hunter Show accepts no responsibility for any injury arising from any failure to comply with the Show Rules. No rider/handler under sixteen years of age on the day of the show is eligible to compete in any classes. **\*Riders & handlers of colts and stallions MUST be at least 18years old.** Proof of age may be required.
14. **The Judge's decision is final.** Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30 minutes of the completion of the class with a £50 cash deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld.
15. The Show Committee reserves the right to rearrange times, amalgamate or cancel classes, and adjust prize money accordingly. They also reserve the sole right to interpret rules and conditions and to finally settle and determine all or any matter, question, or difference arising from Show policy.
16. Bitless bridles, running gags, Market Harborough's, side, draw, or running reins are not allowed in any class. The use of Swales, Sam Marsh bits, and gags with double bridles are actively discouraged.
17. Boots and martingales are not permitted in any flat-ridden class.



18. No tack which conceals an animal's conformation or identifies an animal, its owner, or sponsor is allowed in any ring.
19. It is the sole responsibility of all riders to ensure that whilst mounted, they wear appropriate clothing and footwear and a correctly fitting riding hat/skull cap with an integral adjustable harness complying with the minimum current European standards. These hats are compulsory for competitors aged 18 years and under. This also applies to handlers and grooms.
20. If in the judges/steward's opinion any horse is regarded to compromise the safety of other competitors or spectators, they will be asked to leave the ring.
21. A fall of horse or rider in any ridden class will lead to elimination from the class.
22. Parents/carers of children and young people under the age of 16 years are responsible for their supervision at all times whilst at the Show.
23. Dogs are allowed but **MUST** be on a short lead at all times. (No flexi or extending leads in the vicinity of any horse, ring, box, car park or stable areas). Owners must clean up all mess after their pets.
24. No Smoking in the stable or any indoor area.
25. Equine Flu - Horses must be up to date with their annual vaccination booster (an initial primary course of 3 injections is required for horses more than 5 months old. The second is given between 21 and 92 days after the first and the third is given between 150 and 215 days after the second, and then booster vaccinations given annually thereafter). Must have had their second vaccination at least **7 days** prior to the show.
26. No ridden horses permitted into the collecting ring until the final In Hand Class / championship has entered the ring.
27. All competitors **MUST** declare at the secretary's office.
28. Cash only on the day.
29. Prize money must be collected on the day, and uncollected will be treated as a donation to the show.
30. Only horses entered in a class can be exercised on the showground, riders must wear their back number whenever mounted. Companion animals are allowed in the horse box park or stables only.

**These classes are open to any breed of horse including Irish Draughts.**

- CLASS 11                    **In Hand Hunter Yearling** Filly, Gelding or Colt. Open to any breed to exceed 15hh at maturity.
- CLASS 12                    **In Hand Hunter Youngstock** 2- or 3-year-old Filly, Gelding or Colt. Open to any breed to exceed 15hh at maturity.
- CLASS 21                    **In Hand Hunter** Open to mare or gelding 4 years old and over

## IDHS (GB) AFFILIATED IN HAND IRISH DRAUGHT HORSE

**JUDGE: Miss Sarah Ramsden**

**The Irish Draught Owners & Breeders Group Youngstock Challenge:**

This show is a Qualifier for **The Irish Draught Owners & Breeders Group Youngstock Challenge**. The two highest placed pure-breds from each age group not already qualified in Classes 14, 15, and 16 will qualify. If one or both have already qualified, the horse next in line in each age group will qualify. Horses entered into this class must be eligible under the criteria listed on pages 5, 6, and 7 of this schedule

At the final, there will be three preliminary classes with the two highest placed semi-finalists from each class going forward to the Championship. The Champion will receive £500 and the Reserve Champion £150

- CLASS 14                    **Irish Draught Yearling** - filly, gelding or colt, by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) sire out of an inspected dam



- CLASS 15            **Irish Draught Two Year Old** - filly, gelding or colt or, by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) sire out of an inspected dam.
- CLASS 16            **Irish Draught Three Year Old** - filly, gelding or un-inspected colt, by a Class 1, 2 or RID (GB) sire out of an inspected dam.
- CLASS 17            **Irish Draught Mare / Brood Mare** - Inspected mare, three years old and over, with own foal at foot, barren or in foal.

### **IDHS (GB) AFFILIATED IN HAND IRISH DRAUGHT SPORT HORSE**

**JUDGE: Mrs Sue Stockley-Bridges**

- CLASS 22            **Irish Draught Sport Horse / Part bred - Yearling** filly, gelding or colt, registered on the ID Sport Horse Register
- CLASS 23            **Irish Draught Sport Horse / Part bred Youngstock** - two and three year old filly, gelding or colt. Registered on the ID Sport Horse Register  
*This class will be split if there are sufficient entries in each age group.*
- CLASS 24            **ID Sport Horse / Part bred mare** three years old and over, barren / in foal / or with own foal at foot, registered on the ID Sport Horse Register.

**CHAMPIONSHIP 1    IN HAND ID & ID SPORT HORSE CHAMPIONSHIP**

### **IDHS (GB) AFFILIATED IN HAND MATURITY**

- CLASS 25            **Irish Draught Maturity In-hand** - four years old and over, stallion, mare (barren or in foal only) or gelding registered on the Irish Draught Breed Register
- CLASS 26            **Irish Draught Sport Horse / Part bed Maturity In-hand** - four years old and over, stallion, mare (barren or in foal only) or gelding registered on the ID Sport Horse Register.



## **UNAFFILIATED NOVICE RIDDEN CLASS**

**CLASS 33: NOVICE RIDDEN HORSE:** Over 14.2hh, mare or gelding 4yrs and over. Not to have been placed 1st in any ridden class before 1st January 2025. Exhibits not to be ridden by the judge. Open to any breed

### **Agria Royal International Horse Show British Horse Feeds & Irish Draught Horse Society (GB) Ridden Championship Series**

**JUDGES:** Ride – **Miss Bronte Thompson**  
Conformation – **Mrs Sue Stockley-Bridges**

This show is a qualifier for the British Horse Feeds and IDHS (GB) Ridden Championship Series. The 2 highest-placed horses (not already qualified) from Classes 34 and 35 will qualify for the final to be held at the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead, on July 25th 2026. Qualification can be passed to 3rd place if the highest-placed horses have already qualified and if in the opinion of the judges, the exhibit is of sufficient quality.

- Purebred Irish Draught horses must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB).
- Purebred stallions must be the progeny of a graded mare (ID Class 1, ID Class 2, RID, AID, or Supplementary Grade Up) by an ID Class 1, Class 2, RID(GB) stallion, and be inspected or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) and classified as ID Class 1, Class 2, or RID(GB).
- Owners must be FULL members of the Irish Draught Horse Society (GB).
- Irish Draught Sport Horses and (ID Part bred) horses including stallions must have a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding and must be registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

All horses must be in the correct ownership and must be 4 years and over and 153cm (15hh) or over.

**Class 34 – Ridden Purebred Irish Draught** – Open to mares, stallions and geldings 4 years and over, registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB).

**Class 35 – Ridden Irish Draught Sport Horse (ID Part bred)** – Open to mares, stallions, and geldings 4 years and over, registered on the Irish Draught Sport Horse Register.

#### **Ridden Irish Draught & Irish Draught Part Bred (Sport Horse):**

This show is a qualifier for the £2,000 Ridden Challenge jointly sponsored by the IDHS (GB) and Yorkshire Irish Draught & Hunter Show. The highest placed Pure Bred and Part Bred (not already qualified) from class(es) 34 & 35 will qualify for the final.

In the final, the Champion will be awarded £1,000 prize money, the Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest



placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will receive £100, and the highest placed Irish Draught Part Bred will receive £50.

N.B. Stallions MUST be ridden and handled by an experienced person over the age of 18 and identified by a red, white and blue tail ribbon.

### **OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES:**

**JUDGES:** Ride – **Miss Bronte Thompson**  
Conformation – **Miss Sarah Ramsden.**

Classes 36 – 38 are open to any breed of horse including Irish Draughts.

**CLASS 36:** RIDDEN Mare 4yrs and over open to any breed to exceed 148cm.

**CLASS 37:** RIDDEN COB / MAXI COB, mare or gelding 4yrs and over, open to any breed to exceed 148cm.

**CLASS 38:** RIDDEN HUNTER (Including SMALL HUNTERS) & SPORTS HORSES Over 148cm, mare or gelding 4yrs and over open to any breed.

### **CHAMPIONSHIP 3**

Overall ridden championship – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> prize winners from classes 34 – 38.
